S1 Egg Drop Challenge


'Eggcellent work in the s1 egg drop challenge today. Eggstatic to say all 8 eggs survived'

S1 had to design a way to protect an egg using various materials. We then dropped them from a height and hoped it wouldn't crack.


















National Healthcare Careers Weekend
