We have received the following information about upcoming exciting opportunities throughout the summer holidays:

Dance Leadership SCQF Level 5: There is a Dance Leadership SCQF Level 5 course running during the Summer Holidays Monday 2nd July to Thursday 12th July 2018 here at Portobello HS. The course will run Monday to Thursday both weeks. Each day will start at 10am and finish no later than 4pm. The SCQF Level 5 Award in Dance Leadership is a nationally recognised qualification that enables successful learners to lead small groups in simple dance activities, whilst under the direct supervision of their Tutor/Assessor or other suitably qualified adult. The qualification teaches generic leadership skills such as organisation, planning, communication and teamwork through the medium of dance. It is a fun and practical qualification with no entrance requirements or final examinations to sit.
