The next Autism Focus Teen Triple P Group will run at East Neighbourhood Centre, 101 Niddrie Mains Road, EH16 4DS Monday 28th January- 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019, 1-3pm

This group is suitable for parents/carers who have a child aged 11-16 years who has an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or Social/ Communication difficulties. This group will be delivered by Educational Psychologists who will guide parents through the Teen Triple P programme taking account of the needs of young people with ASD.

We welcome applications directly from parents and carers or from professionals on parent's behalf.
