Activities week is next week! Here's what is happening.

Monday

A normal school day.

Tuesday Key adult starts at 8:30am as normal for all

This is Sports Day. Normal classes will run except for the two periods per year group allocated to the Sports Day. School closes as normal at 3.50pm
